General points of note:-

1. There will be a panel of judges selected by the Show Manager which will include two guest judges from other nations. There will be over judges to act as coordinators of all judges when their best Modena's are chosen to go to Victory Row. All section judges best birds to be ready to move to Victory Row by 1215hrs these will all be moved at the same time on the instructions of the Show Manager.
2. All judging will be in accordance to the NMC of GB Standard.
3. There is to be a special class for Past Presidents this is a one off class for this show with a special prize for the winner.
4. There will be a panel of three judges (five if necessary) to select Best Gazzi, Best Schietti, Best Young Bird and Supreme Modena.
5. There will be Special Prize cards, Rosettes as well as Centenary show mementoes for all exhibitors.
6. Birds can be fed and watered on Friday and after judging on Saturday, corn and drinkers will be supplied. All drinkers to be removed Saturday morning prior to Judging.
7. At the end of judging, judges will be required to provide a critique on their NPA winners for the Special Centenary Show Bulletin which will be published in November.
8. There is to be dedicated security personnel on duty Friday & Saturday night.
9. A photographer will be in attendance.
